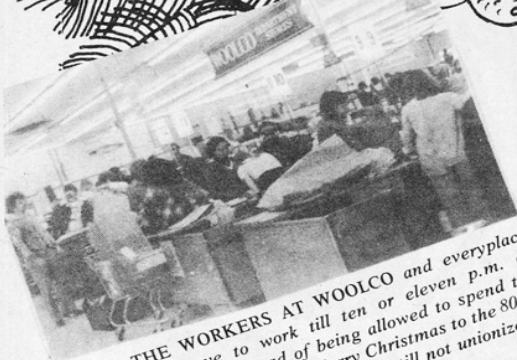


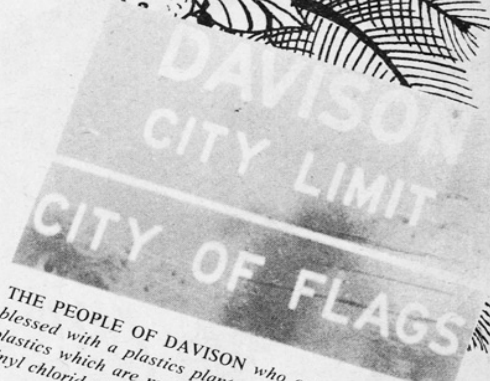
SEASONS GREETINGS TO:

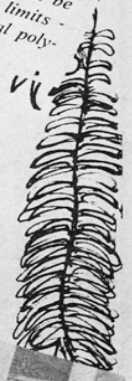


RAY CHARLES FULGHAM still in prison, still being recommended for special parole, still no action from Judge Freeman.

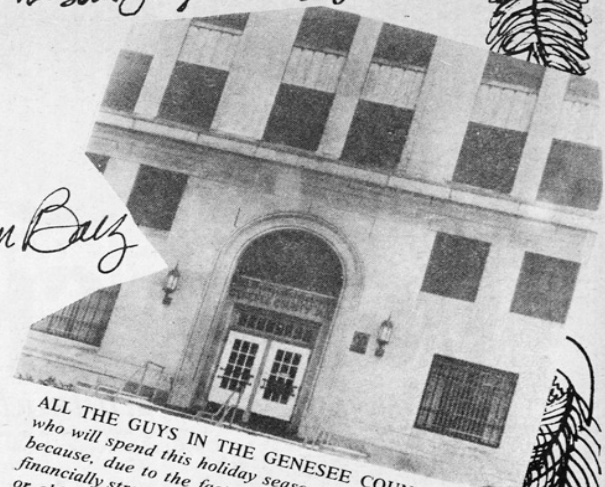

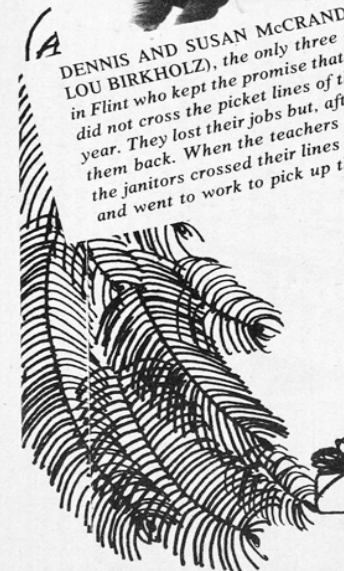
Dear Friends ~
